

PROPER NEEDLE DISPOSAL

Are you disposing of your syringes properly?

Needle Disposal Guidelines...

- Never place an exposed needle in your trash bag where a garbage person may get stuck.
- Use a wide mouth heavy plastic container with a tight lid (detergent or fabric softener container).
- When the container is two-thirds full, tightly close the container and seal with masking or heavy adhesive tape.
- Label the container "DO NOT RECYCLE".
- Discard in regular trash. DO NOT throw in recycling bin.
- NOTE: If you use the container in the home be sure to place it in an area that is not accessible to children or visitors.
- Contact your hauler to see if they have any specific guidelines for the disposal of syringes.
